



Repeating earthquakes happen on locked patches on a creeping fault







Repeating earthquakes are not keeping up with long term slip




Recent models (Cattania and Segall, 2019; Chen and Lapusta, 2009) suggest a solution: aseismic slip and partial ruptures




In Parkfield, we identify repeating and partial rupture sequences






Most of the moment in each sequence is in repeating earthquakes



Partial ruptures don't resolve the difference between seismic slip and long term slip
