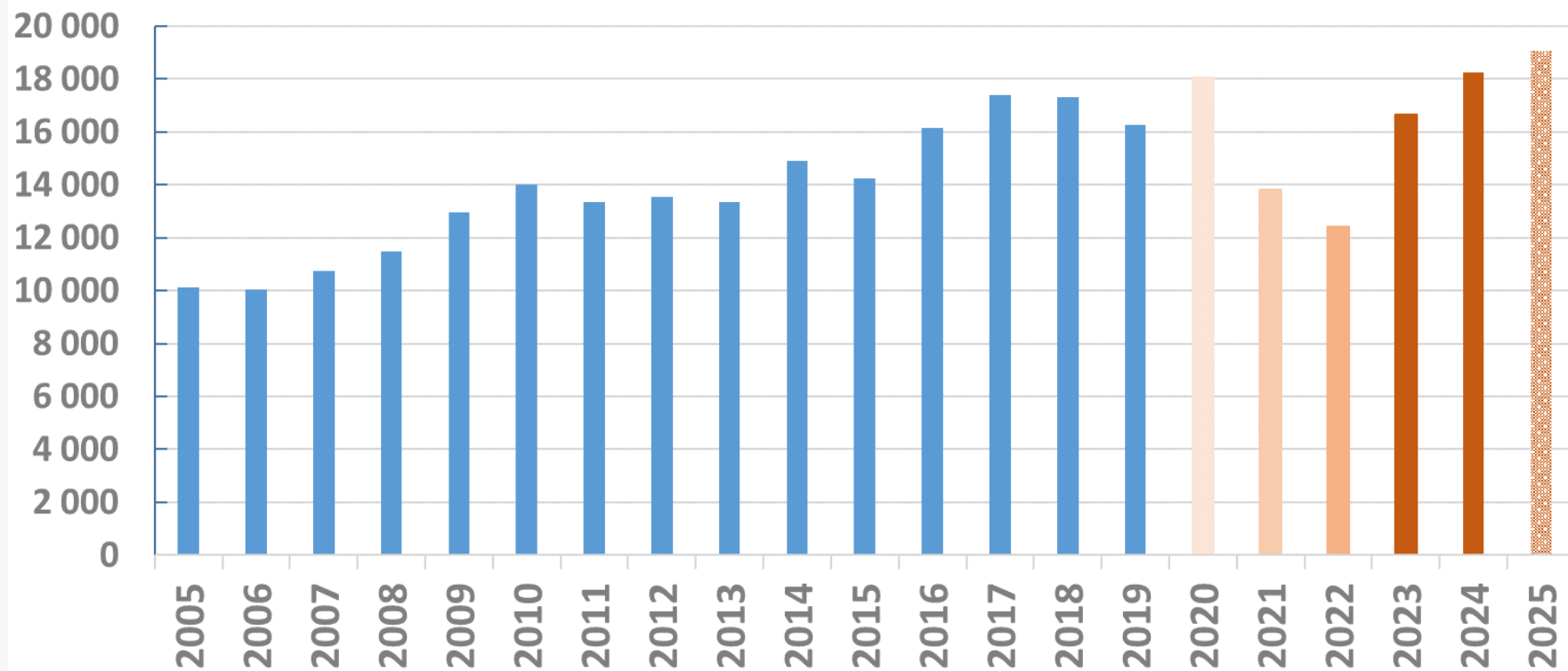
## EGU25: numbers at a glance

It is awarded annually to individuals in recognition of their outstanding contributions to the study of geomorphology, by means of a sustained contribution to a particular research area, the originality, timeliness and significance of their research ***and the broader community service contributions and leadership of the discipline.***

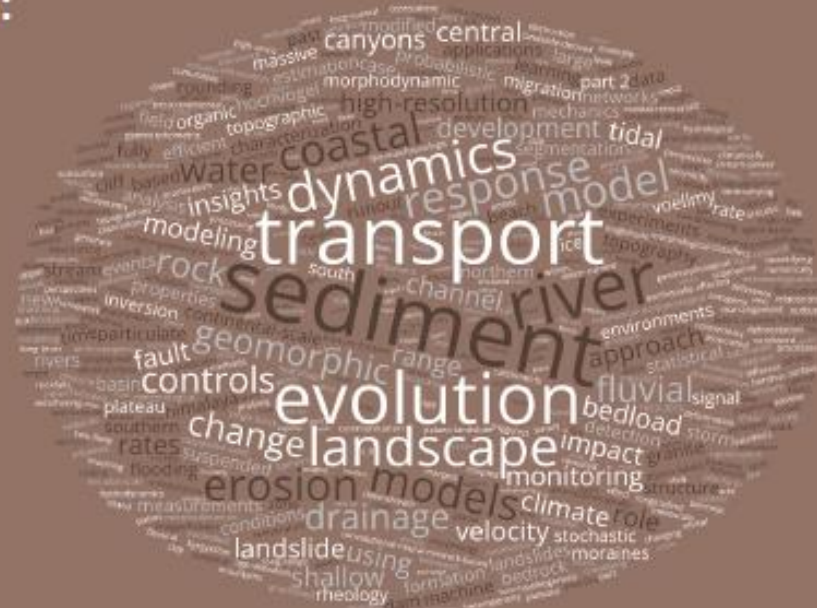

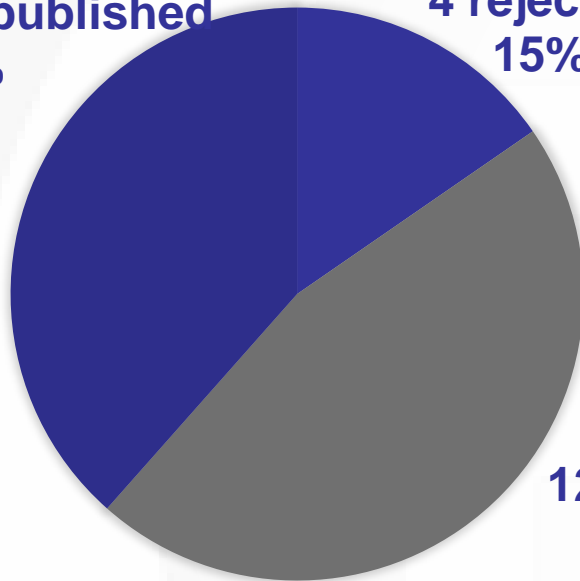

# Outline of the IAG

- **Established in 1979**
- **Consists of about 70 National Scientific Members from the six continents**
- **Launched about 40 Working Groups on various topics**
- **Regularly conducts international and regional conferences**
- **Offers training programs and financial support for young geomorphologists**
- **Publishes quarterly newsletters (Highlights)**
- **Conducts photo/video contests**
- **Celebrates the International Geomorphology Week**
- **Runs a mailing list (GEOMORPHLIST)**
- **Runs social media accounts (Facebook, YouTube)**
- **Has MoUs with EGU, IUGS, IGU, IPA, IAPG, GSA, AAG, etc.**

# Training Programme of the IAG

- Support the training of geomorphologists at an early career stage from around the world, and especially those from economically disadvantaged countries
- Network of Young Geomorphologists' national groups
- IAG grants for: conferences, workshops, events held under the auspices of the IAG
- Since 2002, the IAG has given >260 grants to **YOUNG GEOMORPHOLOGISTS** from ~60 countries

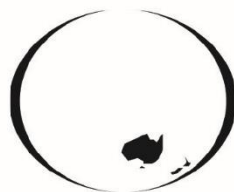

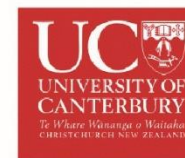
