What is a division meeting?

- Division meetings (DM) are organized annually during the General Assembly (GA).
- EGU Programme Committee (PC) takes care that the division meetings are adequately advertised in the GA programme.
- Division presidents and/or division representatives in the PC should advertise the division meeting at relevant sessions.
- DM are open to all interested meeting participants.
- Young people are especially encouraged to attend.
- Since EGU is a bottom up organization we need your feedback to improve the GA and the EGU.
- We run the EGU for you!



How is the EGU run?

- Council is the highest decision-making body in EGU: Consists of the President (chair), Vice President, General Secretary, Treasurer, Division Presidents and the Executive Secretary.
- **EGU Executive**: Consists of the President, Vice President, General Secretary, Treasurer, and Executive Secretary.
- EGU has eight Union-wide committees reporting to Council:
 - Programme Committee (coordinates the General Assembly)
 - Outreach committee (Education, Outreach, News, and Sponsorship)
 - Publications Committee (EGU journals)
 - Awards Committee (EGU medals)
 - Finance Committee (EGU finances)
 - Nominations Committee (nomination processes)
 - Education Committee (activities related to secondary and tertiary education)
 - Topical Events Committee (topical meetings, conference series, workshops and training schools).



New Union president: Jonathan Bamber

Jonathan Bamber was elected as EGU President/ Vice-President for the term 2016-2020 in the EGU Autumn 2015 elections.

He was inaugurated during the EGU plenary meeting on 18 April 2016 in Vienna.

He served as Vice-President (President-Elect) for the first year, now as the **Union President for two years** and finally as Vice-President (Past-President) for the fourth year.






Aim of our division

EGU General Assembly 2017 Facts


As of 19 April, the Assembly 2017 provides:

- 17,399 papers in programme | +7.87% (2016)
- 4,849 orals | 11,312 posters | 1,238 PICOs | ratio 28 / 65 / 7
- 11,331 registrations in advance | +3.55% (2016)
- 649 unique scientific sessions | 88 short courses | 322 side events*
- 383 out of 649 scientific sessions are co-organized (59%)
- The 383 co-organized include 12 IE sessions with 261 presentations
- Original sessions: 1,432; 1,059 still active, 373 withdrawn
- Withdrawn: 356 scientific sessions and 17 side events

*Side events include: SSE (w/o US), OEM (w/o EOS), STM (w/o SC), FAN, AM



Purpose of Galileo conferences

- Bring together about 100 internationally recognised scientists for a 3-5 days meeting to to discuss and debate issues at the forefront of the discipline.
- Galileo conferences are financed by the participant's registration fees.
- Possibility to publish a special Galileo Conference proceeding issue in one of the EGU journals


Support

- EGU is putting at disposal the conference organization tools: web hosting, abstract, programme and registration management.
- EGU provides comprehensive organisational support by organizing e.g. venue, poster boards, catering, Wi-Fi facilities, etc.
- Support for the participation of Early Career Scientists (up to 5000 €)
- Submission periods are usually from 1. December until end of February of the following year.



Activities of ERE – Scientific Programme

- 2010: 208 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 14 sessions 1.4 % of EGU
- 2011: 395 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 13 sessions 3 % of EGU
- 2012: 418 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 14 sessions 3 % of EGU
- 2013: 398 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 16 sessions 3% of EGU
- 2014: 377 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 19 sessions 2.5 % of EGU
- 2015: 435 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 27 sessions 3.1 % of EGU
- 2016: 458 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 20 sessions 2.9 % of EGU
- 2017: 552 contributions (with ERE in lead) in 19 sessions 3 % of EGU

Division awards

Outstanding Early Career Scientist Award

- Definition: An Early Career Scientists (ECS) is an undergraduate or postgraduate (Masters/PhD) student or a scientist who has received his or her highest degree (BSc, MSc, or PhD) within the past seven years.
 - Provided parental leave fell into that period, up to one year of parental leave time may be added per child, where appropriate.
- Nominations are sought by an open call.
- Proposals need to be submitted to the Division president by 15th June.

Outstanding Student Poster or Pico (OSPP) Award

- Registration is open in association with abstract submission.
- Division president collects team to review the posters or PICOs.
- Awardee receives a conference fee waiver for the next EGU GA and a publication free of charge in an EGU Journal.

Set up skeleton programme for 2018 now

- Keep our aim in mind: Energy, Resources & the Environment.
- Strengthen topics and/or try to cover emerging topics.
- Encourage interdisciplinarity.
- Rotate conveners and include young colleagues.
- Avoid duplications or overlap among sessions.
- Sessions < ~20-25 abstracts will be merged in ERE or across divisions.
- Aim is to have ~ 500 ERE abstracts submitted.





Convener responsibilities

- Define your session by title, description, and organizers
- Consider a PICO session
- Advertise your session and actively attract abstracts
- Rate financial support applications as an input for the support selection committee
- Schedule and run session
 - Only one oral presentation allowed per person
 - Minimize the number of orals from your own organization
 - Encourage poster presentations
 - Observe deadlines and guidelines when setting up the program
 - Defines judges for the OSPP award
 - Attend the EGU GA
 - Ensure that time schedule is kept during oral presentations
- Respond to requests from programme chairman



Division president elections 2017

Division presidents who start their first term now:

- They can be re-elected once. They can stand as candidate this autumn 2017. In case of re-election:
- The division president who is re-elected will appoint a deputy-president for the periods GA 2018 GA 2019 and GA 2019 GA 2020.
- Remember to regardless appoint a deputy president for the upcoming year from GA 2017 to GA 2018.
- Appointed deputy division presidents have to be approved by the division meeting.
- The next election is in 2019, the elected person will become the division deputy president at the GA 2020 and division president at the GA 2021.



Publish in Energy Procedia



- Issues from 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 are published.
- New issue from this GA (last one) to come.
- Any presentation from ERE division or in co-organized sessions is eligible for publications. Oral and poster "no-shows" will be excluded.
- Manuscripts will have 3-10 pages.
- Publication fee per manuscript are 100 EUR.
- Templates will be provided which you have to follow exactly. Send an e-mail to egypro.ere.egu@gfz-potsdam.de if you would like to receive the template. Please add the PDF of your EGU abstract to your mail.
- Deadline for submission of your paper: 15 May 2017
- Publication is planned for September 2017.
- Review will be done by ERE board and conveners of 2017 meeting.
