






## **EGU General Assembly 2016 Facts**


As of 14 April, the Assembly 2016 provides:


- 16,130 papers in programme | +13.34% (2015)

- 10,988 registrations in advance (10,943 already paid) | +23.68% (2015) [-13.77% (2014)]












## Early Career Scientists at EGU

### EGU level

"Young scientist" changed to "Early Career Scientist" and the definition is now:

"An Early Career Scientist (ECS) is an undergraduate or postgraduate (Masters/PhD) student or a scientist who has received his or her highest degree (BSc, MSc, or PhD) within the past seven years\*.

\* Provided parental leave fell into that period, up to one year of parental leave time may be added per child, where appropriate."




- Recruitment of new bloggers (this Tuesday) aim to have more diverse activity on the blog.
- Can EGU get inspiration from APECS? New ideas and initiatives in the coming years.


