Public Peer Review – Excellent idea; weaker papers do not get submitted, and official reviews are public (official reviewers can still be anonymous). Everything gets archived – and is put up very soon after submission.

First EGU Journal to go this route is already the Citation leader in its field – Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics – ACP; ahead of even long established Journals like AGU's Journal of Geophysical Research – Atmospheres. It also has much higher Acceptance rate.

President requested the community to consider submitting to Solid Earth and encouraging colleagues to do likewise.
