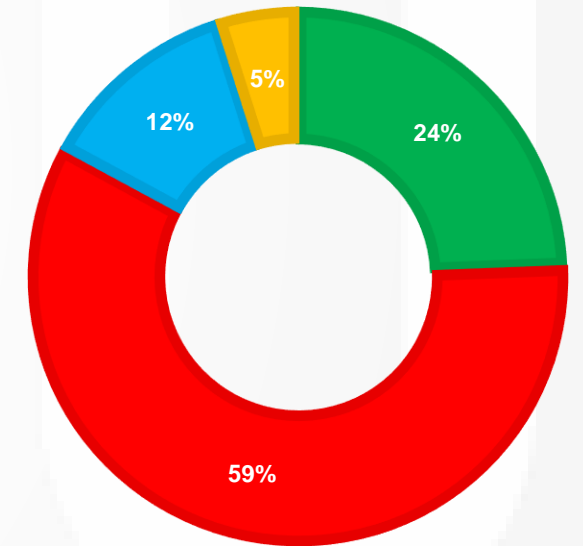
Second step
