Improving the representation of apparent anelastic attenuation variability in regionalised Ground Motion Models in Europe with a focus in mainland France (Georges, P.; Kotha, S. R.; Chaljub, E.)

Pauline Georges is a PhD candidate at the Earth Science Institute, ISTerre, at the Grenoble Alpes university. Her research Pauline Georges focuses on improving the seismic hazard studies especially for shallow earthquakes in Europe. Ground motion model were using general model, but they are now regionalised to better take into account the variability of wave propagation in the crust. She works at developing the next generation of ground motion model by improving the modelisation of apparent anelastic attenuation. In her EGU presentation, she tests different approach to regionalise the apparent anelastic attenuation variability and presents the best approach. The apparent anelastic attenuation variability is then shown at different frequencies and the results are partially analysed.

Strategies for geoelectrical monitoring of subsurface fluid transport processes using Optimized Experimental Design (Menzel, N.; Uhlemann, S.; Wagner, F. M.)

Nino Menzel is a PhD candidate at RWTH Aachen University under the supervision of Prof. Florian Wagner. After completing his Masters in Applied Geosciences in 2022 at RWTH Aachen, Nino started his PhD at the Geophysical Imaging and Monitoring Research and Teaching Unit. His PhD project is funded by the Federal Agency for Nuclear Waste Disposal (BGE) and focuses on improving the predictive quality of simulations relevant for safe disposal and storage of nuclear waste.



Nino Menzel

Nino's current research aims at optimizing geophysical data acquisitions by applying different Optimized Experimental Design (OED) strategies. His primary goal is to develop and adapt a variety of optimization strategies for geophysical monitoring surveys of subsurface fluid flow processes. The awarded poster presented three OED methods that were successfully applied to a synthetic tracer flow simulation. Nino's near-future research goals include the verification of the presented findings in the field as well as further developments in the time-lapse inversion of monitoring data as well as multi-method OED strategies.

## **Early Career Scientist**



- » An Early Career Scientist (ECS) is a student, a PhD candidate, or a practicing scientist who received their highest certificate (e.g. BSc, MSc or PhD) within the past seven years. The seven-year period can be extended to allow for periods when the scientist was not working in science because of, but not limited to, caring and/or parental responsibilities, disability, personal illness, community obligations or national service.
- » For the purpose of the awards the nominee should satisfy one of the above criteria by 1 January of the year when the award is presented.
