- EGU has eight Union-wide committees reporting to Council:




Eight Union-wide committees

EGU General Assembly 2016 facts


As of 14 April, the Assembly 2016 provides:

- 619 unique scientific sessions | 321 side events*
- 10,988 registrations in advance (10,943 already paid) | +23.68% (2015)

*Side events include: GDB, ML, GL, KL, TM, EGU, SC, SPM, DM, EBM, UM, OM




Papers in programme 2005–2016



- Division president collects **team to review** the posters.
- This year c. 25 applications
- Picture, poster published on EGU homepage / newsletter.
- Receives conference fee waiver for the next EGU GA.
- **Publication** free of charge in EGU Journal (normal peer review).
