



## 2011 oral/poster ratio

- 100 oral blocks assigned to hydrology (94 in 2010)
- Oral/total paper ratio ~ 32% (oral/poster ~0.47)

# EGU11 – Scheduling

## Criteria

- Avoid overlap among similar topics
- Conveners' requests
- Uniform distribution of poster sessions during week
- Minimise overlap within subdivisions (but 2 SDs have programs larger than a week)
- Minimise variations in oral/poster ratio between subdivisions (new)
- Rotation of topics scheduled on Friday
- Posters clustered in the 5th block (not an EGU requirement)

# EGU11 – Scheduling

## Constraints

- Number of time blocks and rooms
- Schedule poster after orals (not possible on Friday)
- First author rule (one invited talk is exempted, education sessions are exempted)
- At least 1-2 YS talks per each oral block

A fair solution does not exist – the objective is to minimise the level of injustice.

# 9<sup>th</sup> EGU Assembly: Vienna 2012

## Organising sessions: usual procedures

- Rotation of topics and conveners
- No duplication of and overlap among sessions
- Encourage *poster only* sessions
- Try to cover emerging topics
- Encourage interdisciplinarity
- Sessions with less than ~20 papers: merged or scheduled as poster only.
- **Let's be even more open to young scientists!**



# 9<sup>th</sup> EGU Assembly: Vienna 2011

## Organising sessions: ideas for 2012

- Keep the number of sessions about the same.
- 2 visionary sessions: the HS focus session and 1 topical session. Wednesday morning and Friday morning.
- Consider sessions on Friday
- Repeat short courses for young scientists
- Vienna Catchment Science Symposium




