At Union level:


- The Union Medals for senior scientists including the most prestigious awards made by the Union that are associated with an EGU Honorary Membership (3 in 2013)



Eligible for the **Outstanding Student Poster (OSP) Award** are students that:

- are <u>first author and personally present</u> the poster at the conference;
- satisfy one of the following criteria:
 - are a current BSc, MSc, or PhD student;
 - are a recent undergraduate or postgraduate student (conferral of degree after 1 January of the year preceding the conference) who are presenting her/his thesis work.

Once the programme has been finalized, authors presenting a poster are invited to register for the award. Their data are then transferred to the respective Division Award Committee, which selects the best poster paper at the meeting.




8 student registrations for Division OSP in 2013 Why so few?






Red level - G

Compared to Registration Status:



5.6 Keywords

The aim of the keyword module during scheduling is to avoid thematic overlaps.

Hence keywords should cover large areas, <u>not</u> be session specific. Only a very limited number of keywords per division (or preferably between divisions) can be admitted.

Proposal:

Solid Earth – EGU journal in geosciences.

Two-stage publications with public peer-review and interactive public discussions.

The discussion and peer-review of submitted papers are handled in the open access discussion forums (e.g., Solid Earth Discussions),

Final papers, upon acceptance, appear in the corresponding peerreview journals (e.g. Solid Earth).
