GA statistics


(as of 17 April 2021, 11.30)

- 13,981 abstracts in programme | -24% relative to 2020
- 636 unique scientific sessions (vPICO)
- 56 short courses online
- 71% Sessions with EDI logo (multiple countries, at least one ECS, gender diversity)
- Week 1 (19-23 Apr): Union Symposia | Great Debates (Except GDB1) | most Medal and Award Lectures | most Division Meetings | 2 Short Courses per day

 CR org: 603 abstracts in 23 sessions → +46%
 25 oral blocks: 24 Abstracts/oral block
 6 PICOs
- 2019: 1206 abstracts ↑, 22 oral blocks | 6 PICOs CR org: 412 abstracts in 18 sessions → -17%
 20 oral blocks: 21 Abstracts/oral block
- 2018: 1018 abstracts ↓, 22 oral blocks | 6 PICOs

Cryosphere Early Career Scientist

"... an undergraduate or postgraduate (Masters/PhD) student or a scientist who has received his or her highest degree (BSc, MSc, or PhD) within the past seven years*

*where appropriate, the seven-year period can be extended to allow for periods when the scientist was not working in science because of, but not limited to, caring and/or parental responsibilities, disability, personal illness, community obligations or national service

- ECS = 56% of Cryosphere Division
- Divisional ECS Reps put together a strategy to guide union-wide ECS Rep
- Aim to actively shape the GA and wider EGU activity
- Represent issues and topics key to Earlier Career Scientists!


