



# INFO from the Division and the Union





## From Stephan Mueller/Marie Tharp Medal to Marie Tharp Medal

After two decades of honoring Stephan Mueller with the TS Medal — including the last four years as the Mueller/Tharp Medal — the TS Division will begin awarding the Marie Tharp Medal starting in **2026**.

#### History of the TS medal re-naming:

- 2019 Initial Discussion on Medal Renaming
- 2020 Community Feedback and Initial Survey
- 2021 Introduction of two medals
- 2023 Formal Advocacy from the TS Medal Committee for a single Medal named after Marie Tharp
- 2024 The EGU Council formally approved the Renaming of the TS Medal after Marie Tharp





## The Marie Tharp Medal

Awarded to scientists in recognition of their outstanding contributions to tectonics and structural geology. Acknowledges exceptional scientific achievements in advancing the understanding of tectonic processes that shape Earth's lithosphere and research that bridges these disciplines across spatial and temporal scales.

#### Marie Tharp Medal:

Acknowledges exceptional scientific achievements in advancing the understanding of tectonic processes that shape Earth's lithosphere and research that bridges these disciplines across spatial and temporal scales.

#### **Outstanding Early Career Scientist:**

Recognises scientific achievement made by an Early Career Scientist in the field(s) covered by the related division.






**Active sessions in ITS and Disciplinary Programme Groups**





- First session program (October)
- Call-for-abstracts
- Session merges... (January)
- Final session program (February)





## How do we build the program?

Please consider that it is VERY (!!) easy to propose a session...but it implies possible later session merges...

Check what has already been proposed before proposing new sessions.

And...the GA is 5 days long from 08.30 on Monday to 19.00 on Friday. Sessions on Monday morning or Friday afternoon are not punishments, just part of the official program!
