

### **EGU23 Registration Statistics**

- o 19,319 active scheduled abstracts (2023: 16,604)
- o 16,746 paid registrations\* (2023: 16,319)
- 8% of total participants registered for virtual participation (2023: 13%)
- 37% of onsite and 50% of virtual participants are PhD candidates, MSc or undergraduate students
- 2% of registered onsite and 24% of online participants are from low- & lower-middle income countries (2023: 5% and approx. equally distributed onsite & virtual participation)




