
- Passed away in February 2019




### Presentation ratio 2005-2019



### Call for Sessions 2019 - (New) Rules by EGU



- No self-solicited presentations by conveners
- (Co)-conveners cannot be presenting author and are discouraged from being coauthor of oral presentations in a session they convene.
- Authors are allowed as first author to submit either one regular abstract plus one abstract solicited by a convener, or two solicited abstracts.
