# EGU General Assembly 2014 Facts


As of 26 April, the Assembly 2014 provides:

- 10,261 Registrations in Advance (10,176 already paid) | +3.9% (2013)






#### Papers in Programme 2005–2014








#### Presentation Ratio 2005–2014











  - be age 35\* or younger.
  - be an undergraduate or postgraduate (Masters/PhD) student or have received her/his highest degree qualification (e.g., BSc, MSc, PhD) within the last seven\* years.

#### • Established Scientist's Travel Award (ESTA):

- a free registration together with a refund of the Abstract Processing Charge (<u>APC</u>)
- additional financial support for the travel expenditures with a maximum of €300.
- lower middle income countries

  - Major national and international field campaigns and observational research programs;
  - New observational strategies to address societal needs in areas such as monitoring climate change and preventing natural disasters;








# Looking for ideas to bring to the Council

- EGU is a VERY healthy organization in terms of money. It has a huge reserve that can be spend in several ways
- My impression is that the Council and the committees are looking for new good ideas to move forward.
- Examples
  - Organize a transversal demonstrative workshop of informatics for the science
  - Introducing the informatics into secondary schools as a tool for disseminating science
  - A new publication about informatics.
  - Stimulate the usage of Free/Open software/tools committee including support to low income countries
  - An European ciberinfrastructure equivalent to Earthcube for Europe (or more modestly sponsor, *e.g.*, Pangaea or other data repositories)
- But we need people to push those ideas and propose them to the committees and to the Council.
