

- Intention: post call by Summer 2025





"... an undergraduate or postgraduate (Masters/PhD) student or a scientist who has received his or her highest degree (BSc, MSc, or PhD) within the past seven years\* "

\*where appropriate, the seven-year period can be extended to allow for periods when the scientist was not working in science because of, but not limited to, caring and/or parental responsibilities, disability, personal illness, community obligations or national service

- ECS = 60% of Cryosphere Division
- Divisional ECS Reps put together a strategy to guide union-wide ECS Rep
- Aim to actively shape the GA and wider EGU activity
- Represent issues and topics key to Earlier Career Scientists!





- Submission to publication: 280 days (open discussion 30 d after submission!)
- Editors spend on average 1.4 hours securing reviewers for manuscripts

The 2025 Medal is awarded to Shin Sugiyama for outstanding work in the field of glacier dynamics and ice-water interactions, including seminal contributions to our understanding of lake-calving glaciers and ice-dammed lake outbursts.





# **Brice Noël**

Arne Richter Award for Outstanding ECS

The 2025 Award is conferred to Brice Noël for outstanding research in the field of surface mass budgets of ice caps and ice sheets, based on regional climate modelling.

# **EGU Special Activity Fund 2026 – call for proposals**

**Goal:** Promote high-profile, 'out-of-the-box', not-profit activities contributing to EGU's goals and mission, i.e. advancing studies and research in the Earth, planetary and space sciences (<a href="https://www.egu.eu/about/statutes/">https://www.egu.eu/about/statutes/</a>)

**Key points**: 20-25kEUR per project; funds up to a dozen projects available; projects to happen in 2026

No activities covered by other funds (e.g. training courses or conferences)

- **Application process**: Concept note due by Fri 13 June 2025
  - Full proposals (upon invitation by mid-July) due by Fri 19 Sept 2025
