EGU General Assembly 2012 Facts


As of 19 April, the Assembly 2012 provides:

- 13,528 Papers in Programme | +1.5% (2011)
- 4,436 Orals | 9,092 Posters | Ratio 33 / 67
- 530 unique scientific Sessions | 157 PSD Sessions | 165 Side Events*
- 8,743 Registrations in Advance (thereof 8,639 already paid) | +14.9% (2011)






Papers in Programme 2005–2012








Oral/Poster Ratio 2005–2012



Ian McHarg Stamp (Palau)

- He received numerous awards (including the Harvard Lifetime Achievement Award) and 15 medals
- His 1969 book Design with Nature pioneered the concept of ecological planning. It continues to be one of the most widely celebrated books on landscape architecture and land-use planning. In this book, he set forth the basic concepts that were to develop later in Geographic Information Systems.

Ian McHarg Medal 2012



Peter Fox

The 2012 Ian McHarg Medal is awarded to Peter Fox for his contribution to recognizing the fundamental importance of establishing informatics as a genuine discipline within the Earth Sciences.

Resumé:

Since 1985 Peter Fox has been bridging science and distributed data and information systems to support community activities. His science has utilized state-of-the-art modeling techniques, and high performance computing services and their recent commodification on the 'grid'. But the requirements of accessing large-scale distributed scientific repositories and managing data life-cycles has led first to an engagement and then leadership in advancing the use of information technology and informatics in the earth sciences. Notwithstanding his considerable scientific and technical achievements, Fox's leadership in establishing earth science informatics as discipline in its own right is a core element of this nomination, and it is here that he has made his particular impact on the European Geosciences Union. Fox is a tireless advocate for Earth and Space Science Informatics, but always leading from the front, presenting multiple original research papers at every


