

# Welcome to the 2022 TS Division Meeting





#### • Why did you change the date of EGU22 from early April to late May?

EGU22 FAQs

This decision was made in January at the beginning of the omicron wave. There was considerable anxiety within the community about attending an in-person event in these conditions. Moreover, Austria limited the maximum event size to 2000 seated people (and even less standing), with no indication of when that rule would be relaxed.

Under these conditions, when the ACV proposed an alternative date (due to the cancellation of another conference) we decided to do this, in order to maximise the chance of having an in-person component to EGU22







#### Will the date of the General Assembly change again in future?

This was the first time in the history of the EGU General Assembly that we have had to change the date and we sincerely hope it will be the last!

We are currently not announcing the date of the the 2023 General Assembly because we are investigating with the ACV the most appropriate schedule for EGU23 (in April and May) with the aim to be more resilient to potential new COVID infection waves





#### • Why are there no posters or PICOs this year?

EGU22 FAQs

We originally had to provide a hygiene plan to the Austrian authorities. Including posters and PICOs in the programme appeared as a major risk in getting the plan approved.

Large numbers of non-seated people mixing in closed spaces are viewed as too much of a risk to our attendee's health, safety and well-being in the current pandemic situation.







#### Austria relaxed the Covid regulations. Why are you maintaining the 2G and mask requirements?

The Austrian authorities announced the relaxation of the regulations after our deadline for on-site registration. Due to the requirements of our conference hygiene plan, it was not possible to re-open the registration. We felt that participants had signed up for an in-person event under certain conditions and we did not want to modify this after participants had registered. The health and safety of all participants is our primary concern. In addition, we were advised to maintain a 2G conference given the unpredictable nature of regulation changes.

The 2022 Marie Tharp Medal is awarded to Francesca Funiciello in recognition of remarkable achievements in convergent margin geodynamics and for pioneering use of analogue modelling to investigate tectonic processes.

## 2021 open letters to EGU



Regarding medals and criteria to award them – TS community involved in both

- "The awards and medals programme does not presently reflect the diversity of scientists undertaking science, nor how science is done"... "We encourage EGU to review what is considered as 'excellent', 'eminent' and 'outstanding'" 6<sup>th</sup> of April 2021
- EGU started an internal review regarding the awards and medal system. A few changes already happened:

OECS Award: Review of the eligibility criteria

Exclusion of metrics from nomination requests

EGU president and council appreciated the constructive feedback

The letter started a debate inside council that also involves how to handle democratic tools.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of July there was a meeting between the original authors of the letter – Bond, Mildon, Gurer, Davies, Perez Diaz – the EGU president Glaves, the EDI chair Alves de Jesus-Rydin and TS President

- 1. EGU plans to collect & publish diversity data (gender, career stage, location) annually
- 2. Reviewing EGU medals and awards naming to transparency over the process
- 3. Creating safe & inclusive spaces for difficult conversations









## **EGU22: Registration numbers and breakdown**

- On-site participants: 88 countries




- 5695 virtual registrations (20/05 21:00)
