EGU25: numbers at a glance


- 1,103 active sessions in total (+7% EGU24):



Abstracts in (lead) sessions per Programme Group (PG)



- For the purpose of the awards the nominee should satisfy one of the above criteria by 1 January of the year when the award is presented.
