





<u>Imaggeo</u>, is the online open-access geosciences image repository of the European Geosciences Union. Every geoscientist who is an amateur photographer (but also other people) can submit their images to this repository. Being open access, it can be used by scientists for their presentations or publications as well as by the press. If you submit your images to imaggeo, you retain full rights of use, since they are licenced and distributed by EGU under a Creative Commons licence.

Division Pages



Associated to Imaggeo, the EGU organizes an annual photo competition and related exhibit at its General Assembly. Every conference participant can submit up to three photos on any broad theme related to the Earth, space and planetary sciences. Submitted entries are automatically made available to all from imaggeo. A panel of judges chooses between eight and fifteen finalist photographs for exhibition at the General Assembly, where each participant can vote on their favourite photos. The three winners receive a free registration to the following General Assembly.


As of 04 April, the Assembly 2013 provides:

- 4,684 Orals | 8,207 Posters | 452 PICOs | Ratio 35 / 62 / 3
- 448 unique scientific Sessions | 96 PSD Sessions | 143 Side Events\*
- 9,876 Registrations in Advance (thereof 8,631 already paid) | +13.0% (2012)


### Participants at EGU Assemblies 2005–2012

#### Jean Baptiste Lamarck Medal

The <u>Jean Baptiste Lamarck</u> Medal is established by the Division on Stratigraphy, Sedimentology and Paleontology in recognition of the scientific achievement of Jean Baptiste Lamarck.

It is reserved for scientists for their exceptional contributions to either Stratigraphy, Sedimentology or Paleontology. The medal will be awarded each year, alternating between the three subdivisions, so that each third year a Stratigrapher, Sedimentologist or Paleontologist will be awarded.

The medal has been exclusively designed for the EGU by József Kótai.
