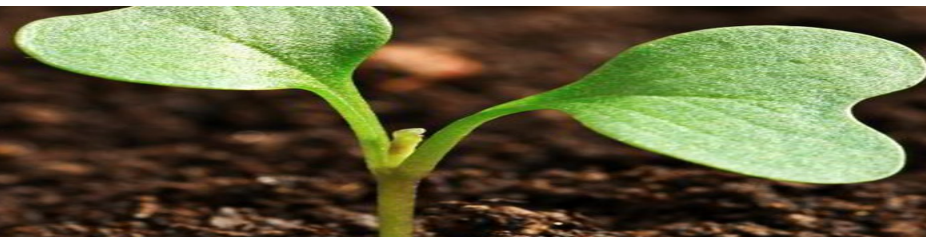


EGU22 FAQs

- *Why did EGU change the date of EGU22 GA from early April to late May?*

This decision was made in January at the beginning of the Omicron wave. There was considerable anxiety within the community about attending an in-person event in these conditions. Moreover, Austria limited the max event size to 2,000 seated people (and even less standing), with no indication of when that rule would be relaxed.

Under these conditions, when the ACV proposed an alternative date (due to the cancellation of another conference), EGU decided to do this, in order to maximise the chance of having an in-person component to EGU22.



EGU22 FAQs

- *Will the date of the General Assembly change again in future?*

This was the first time that EGU has had to change the date (and we sincerely hope it will be the last!).

EGU is currently not announcing the date of the 2023 General Assembly. Originally it was planned for early April, but a date in May would be more resilient with regards to possible new Covid infection waves.

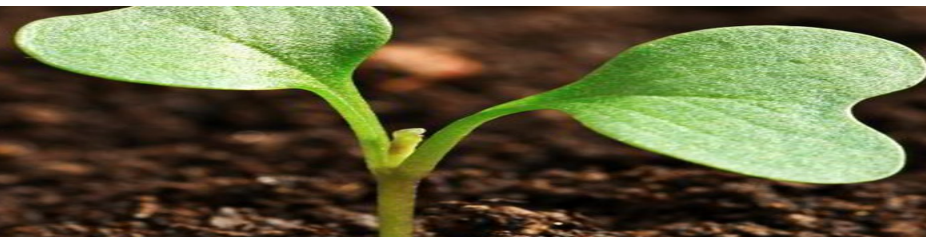


EGU22 FAQs

- *Why are there no posters or PICOs this year?*

EGU originally had to provide a hygiene plan to the Austrian authorities. Including posters and PICOs in the programme appeared as a major risk in getting the plan approved.

Large numbers of non-seated people mixing in closed spaces are viewed as too much of a risk to our attendee's health, safety and well-being in the current pandemic situation.

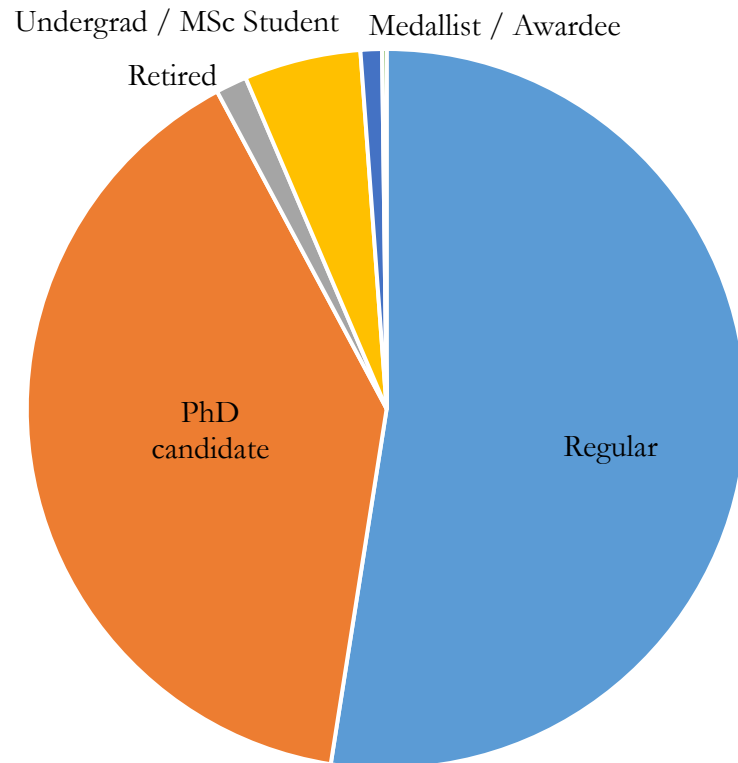

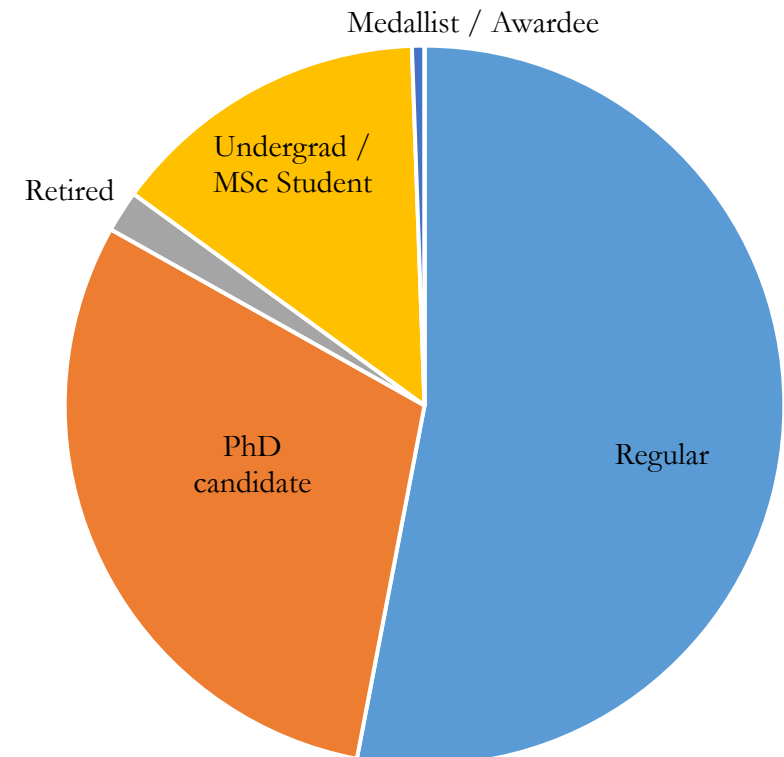


EGU22: Registration numbers and breakdown

Participant status - on site



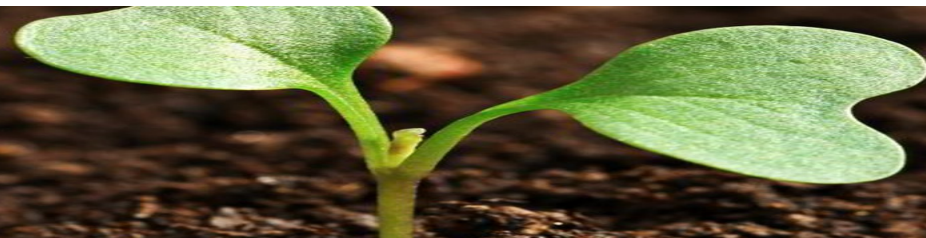
Participant status - virtual

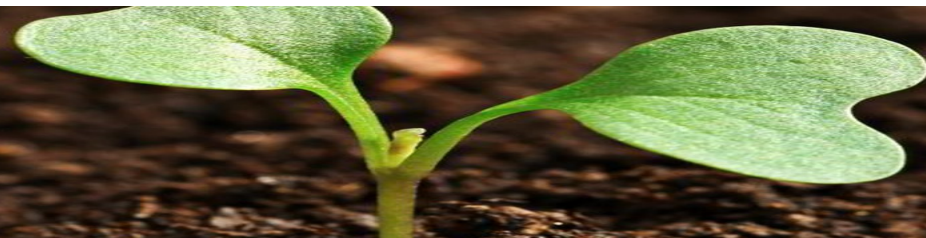
Equality, Diversity & Inclusion at EGU22

3. include conveners that represent **more than one form of gender identity**.

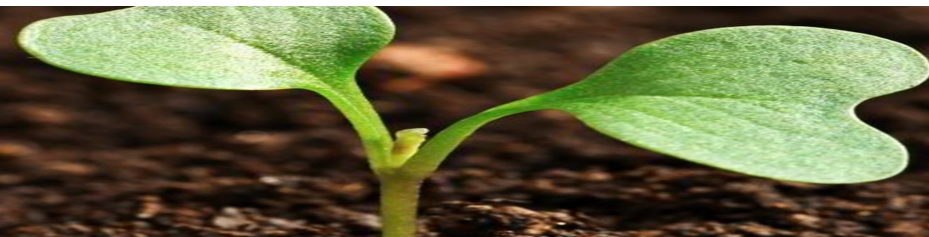


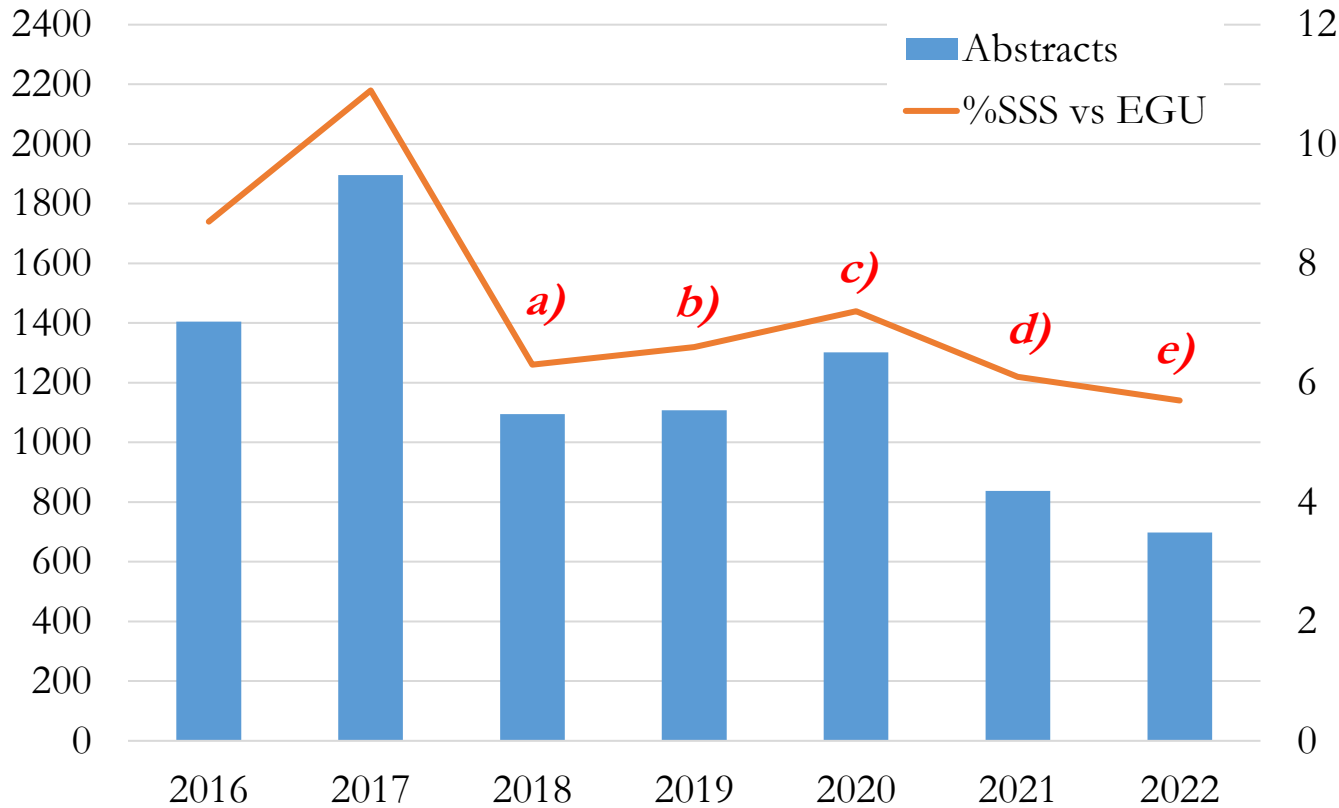

Changes in the EGU format with time...

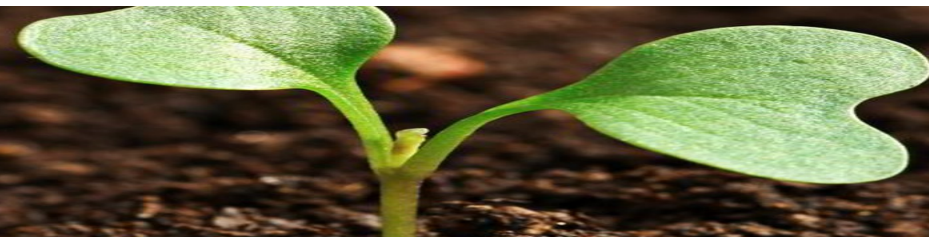

- ALL EGU participants (from post-doc level on, not co-author, no shared affiliation) can vote as well on abstract page!

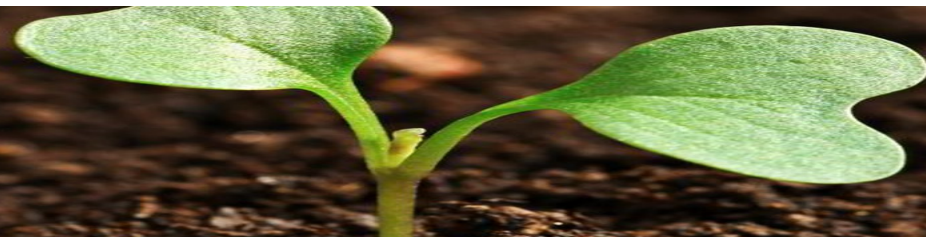

- presentation (organization, aesthetic appeal, ability to answer questions, ...)





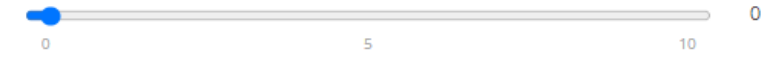

** An Early Career Scientist (ECS) is a student, a PhD candidate, or a practising scientist who received their highest certificate (e.g. BSc, MSc or PhD) within the past 7 years. The 7-year period can be extended to allow for periods when the scientist was not working in science because of, but not limited to, caring and/or parental responsibilities, disability, personal illness, community obligations or national service. For the purpose of the awards the nominee should satisfy one of the above criteria by 1 January of the year when the award is presented.*

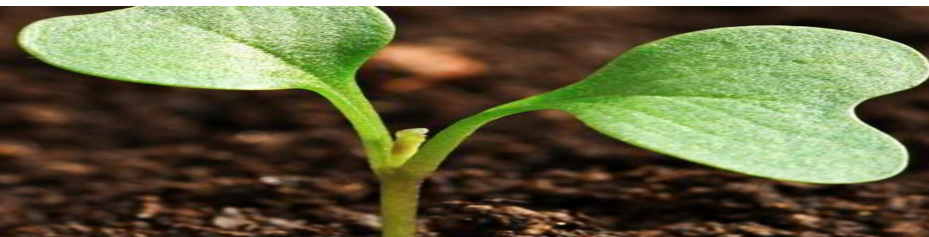
