

# **Evaluation**

Your performance will be evaluated by a panel of 2 ECS and 2 non-ECS. The evaluation will be based on the following points:

- speaker qualities: clear expression; enthusiasm; interaction with the audience and of course if the presentation was entertaining.
- structure: clear purpose of research; clear presentation of the context; good succession of ideas and the added value of the one slide.
