### **EGU General Assembly 2018 facts**

As of 5 April (12:45), the Assembly 2018 provides:

- 17,323 papers in programme | -0.44% (2017)
- 4,776 orals | 11,128 posters | 1,419 PICOs | ratio 28 / 64 / 8
- 12,733 registrations in advance | +12.37% (2017)
- 666 unique scientific sessions | 68 short courses | 294 side events\*
- 433 out of 666 scientific sessions are co-organized (65%)
- The 433 co-organized include 20 IE sessions with 459 presentations
- Original sessions: 1,355; 1,028 still active, 327 withdrawn
- Withdrawn: 309 scientific sessions, 7 SC, and 11 side events



#### Papers in programme 2005–2018





#### **Presentation ratio 2005–2018**





# Geosciences New for GA 2019

- No solicited presentations by conveners: "Authors (first and co-authors) should not have a solicited presentation in a session they (co-)convene. (Co)-conveners should not be presenting author, and are discouraged from being co-author, on oral presentations in a session they convene."
- <u>1 abstract rule</u>: "Authors are allowed as first author to submit either one regular abstract plus one abstract solicited by a convener, or two solicited abstracts."
- <u>Number of conveners on a session</u>: At session submission minimum 2 – maximum 5
- <u>Number of convenerships</u> as a recommendation: 1 as main convener, maximum 3 (co-)convenerships total

He was awarded the 2016 Nobel Prize in physics along with David Thouless and Duncan Haldane for work on condensed matter physics



A nomination package for the Division medals should consist of

Nomination letter (1 page).

Curriculum Vitae (2 pages). A summary of the candidate's CV, including the candidate's name, address, history of employment, degrees, research experience, honours, and service to the community.

Selected bibliography (2 pages). A list of selected publications by the candidate that best support the nomination. It should also state briefly the candidate's total number and types of publications and citations.

Supporting letters. Between 3 and 5 letters of support (maximum 1 page each) should be submitted. These letters should clearly establish the nominee's recognized contribution to the field.
