
- 15 NH sessions led by other divisions (509 abstracts)

- Oral sessions were TB1 to TB4.








Soloviev Medal Committee

Rules for Committee:

Chair: Past Medallist. Term is 4 years.

Members: Four past medallists. Term 4 years*, one member replaced each year.

Ex-officio: Division President or VP, chair UAC

*During next few years, 1-2 members may serve 3 years, so that staggering of one person being replaced each year can be achieved.



9.0 MEDALS & NOMINATIONS CALL

EGU Plinius Medal

Medal awarded to an excellent young scientist* who has outstanding research achievements in a field related with natural hazards, important interdisciplinary activity in two or more fields related with topic, and research focused on mitigation of natural risks.

 *Young scientist: By 1 January of year award presented:
 (1) be an undergraduate or postgrad student, or received his/her degree within last 7 years; AND (2) in age ≤ 35.
 (Where appropriate, up to one year of parental leave may be added per child.)







Below minutes taken by Bruce D Malamud (BDM) and Stefano Tinti (ST) during the NH meeting

- (a) NUMBERS PRESENT. [JAH counted] 110-130 people present, depending on time during the meeting.
- (b) AGENDA ACCEPTED. BDM presented points 1 to 9 and 12, and ST presented 10 to 11.
- (c) OFFICERS STEPPING DOWN individually thanked.
- (d) MEDAL COMMITTEES. All proposed medal committee compositions were individually voted on, by person, and accepted with no discussion [1-2 people abstained, and in all cases, 100% of those people voting accepted the nominations]. Note that exception was agreed and voted on for Soloviev Committee such that a non-past medallist would serve on the committee as member.

(e) PLINIUS MEDAL. Proposal by BDM/ST to consider that the OYSA would be the NH Division 'young scientist' award, and we should consider moving the Plinius Medal to be a 'mid-career' medal. The mechanics would still need to be worked on (e.g., what defines 'midcareer'?), but the general premise of moving towards this was accepted in a vote, with 100% of those voting accepting. The specific guidelines would be presented (and voted on) in one year at the EGU GA 2012 NH business meeting. No changes for OYSA or Plinius would occur during 2011/12 cycle of awards.



(f) SCIENTIFIC OFFICERS. All proposed new scientific officers were individually voted on, by person, and accepted with no discussion [1-2 people abstained, and in all cases, 100% of those people voting accepted the nominations].



(g) DISCUSSION: "Snow Avalanches & Glacial Hazards" subdivision of the programme has had at most 1 session led by NH each year, ranging from 25-35 abstracts each year. Should we consider folding this sub-programme group (recognizing that the topic itself is of interest) into "Environmental and Other Hazards" sub-programme group? Discussion that we should encourage the scientific officer to actively work with CR and the community to bring in more sessions and re-evaluate next business meeting
