

Memorandum on cooperation between JPGU and EGU

In order to promote research in the Earth and Planetary sciences, the European Geoscience Union (EGU) and the Japan Geoscience Union (JPGU) will cooperate to enhance the activity of their members.

1. The JPGU and EGU will distribute the following information to their respective members by email, newsletters or web servers.

- Information on meetings convened by either side.
- Information on research employment.
- Other information that will benefit researchers.
- Information on scientific publications

The means of circulation of information will be coordinated between both parties' secretariats.

2. A link to the JPGU/EGU homepage will be posted on the "collaboration with national and international geophysical societies' section" link from the homepage of EGU and JPGU using the logos of JPGU/EGU.


3. At both parties' annual conferences, a co-sponsored session by EGU/JPGU will be encouraged.

4. At the EGU/JPGU annual conferences, if requested, an exhibition booth will be provided free of charge.

5. The executive officers of EGU and JPGU will undertake to have a meeting once a year to discuss this cooperation. This meeting will be held at an appropriate EGU or JPGU annual meeting.

The agreements in this memorandum become effective on January 1st, 2007 .

ANNEX I: ANNUAL MEETING REGISTRATION


Each organization will offer members of the other organization registration at member rates at its annual meetings.
